1959, at Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan, at 9:30 a.m.

After some enquiry as to the Principles, Policy and Organisation of the Party, it was resolved to call a meeting for further discussion on Monday, July 13, at 6 p.m. in Mr. Shroff's office. A meeting of the members of the Organising Committee with Shri Rajagopalachari and Professor Ranga was arranged for Monday, July 6 at 9 a.m.

The programme for Rajaji's visit was finalised. Mr. Masani would take the Chair at the Public Meeting at the Kannada Education Society High School, and Sir H. P. Mody for the one at Sunderbai Hall.

In response to the request for a permanent office, Mr. Shroff agreed to arrange for this in Sassoon Building, where CEAT is now.

The Chairman read the Statement of the financial position. The balance with the Bank on July 3, 1959 was Rs. 7801 .87nP and the cash in hand Rs. 161 . 77nP.

Sir H. P. Mody was requested to be Honorary Treasurer.

- Mr. Shroff said that two sorts of funds would be required : Capital and Revenue and suggested the framing of a tentative budget. Dr. Cooper was requested to prepare a budget for the office.

The suggestion that small meetings should be organised all over the city and suburbs was approved.

The Committee also approved Mr. Mistry's suggestion that symposiums be held where people from different walks of life - students, office workers, lawyers & businessmen could speak on 'Why I would like to join the Swatantra Party'.

The next meeting of the Committee was fixed for Monday, July 13 at 6 p.m.
