A meeting of the Executive Committee of the Swatantra Party, Bombay Region, was held on Friday, the 9th June, 1972 at 6.15.p.m. at the Party's Office when the following members were present:

2. Minutes of the meeting held on 24th April, 1972 were read and confirmed.

3. Arising out of the minutes of the previous meeting, the President said that he had contacted some individuals and was hopeful that some monetary help would come forward. Mr. Parmanand Kejriwal offered a monthly contribution of Rs. 200/- from June 1972. It was then decided that Mr. Madhu Mehta, Mr. Parmanand Kejriwal, Mr. Shantilal That and Mrs. Sarla Datar would meet at the Party's Office on Friday the 16th June at 6.00.p.m. to chalk out a programme for fund collection drive.

In regard to membership campaign, the President explained that the Party membership in Bombay Region should be increased to a minimum of 5000 by the end of this year. He suggested that each unit should enroll minimum of further 25 members immediately in order that all the units should function effectively.

The President then explained the programme he had in view about launching a Satyagraha to focuss the attention of the public in regard to the unjustified appointment of Dr. Pophale, as Hon. Professor, after his retirement from the St. George's Hospital, which was in contravention to the Maharashtra Government's Resolution of 1966. He added that for this purpose, a meeting of the active workers had been convened on 10th June at the Party Office and he

expected more people to be present. (The Satyagraha programme, although decided on a large scale did not take place, as Dr.Pophale resigned from his new assignment on 12th June.)

The remaining items of the Agenda were deferred for the next meeting.

With a vote of thanks to the Chair, the meeting terminated at 8.00 p.m.
