You will remember that you had written to me on 25th February about the Anandpur Barrage Project. I had taken the matter up immediately with Dr. K. L. Rao, Minister for Irrigation and Power of the Indian Government.

I have now received a reply from Dr. Rao, in the course of which he says:

"The Project Report received from the State Government is under technical examination in the Central Water and Power Commission. I understand that the Commission have sent their comments to the State Government and have requested them to send their replies and also send an officer for discussions so as to finalise the scheme and cost estimates. I have asked the Commission to expedite their scrutiny and place the project report before the Advisory Committee for clearance of Irrigation, Power and Flood Control Projects, at an early date."

I trust the State Government are responding to the suggestions made by the Central Water and Power Commission and that you have found it possible to make rapid progress with the Project.
