My dear Mr. Bhabha,

Will you please refer to Mr. Masani's talk with you on the 29th May, 1967. 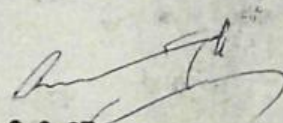
