My dear Revered Rajaji,

On reaching here from New Delhi on the 6th instt. by G.T.Express, I found a telegram from Shri Massani asking me to attend the Convention of members of the Swantantra party at Bombay on 7th. As I was very ill, I immediately sent him a telegram that I am unable to attend the Convention as desired owing to my illness. I also added that letter followed.

You are aware that in my last letter to you from New Delhi, I stated that I ~~will~~^{would} keep my whole correspondence before the Executive Committee of the Nag-Vidarbha Andolan Samiti to give me their advice as to whether I should join the Swantantra party as a full-fledged member or an associate member or should sit in the House as a solitary member as one unattached or independant member!
