My dear Rajaji,

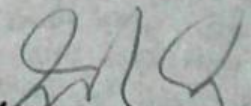

This is a very good idea and we can have a meeting of the Organisation Sub Committee as soon as you confirm that you will be in Delhi definitely on the 23rd and 24th.

In so far as the Parliamentary Sub Committee is concerned I think there is no business to be placed before it to justify calling 12 people from all over India. People get fed up when there is nothing to discuss and decide upon.
