With reference to your letter No.SFPO/212/A/63 of March 26, I enclose herewith draft amendments to the Finance Bill and one amendment to the Super Profits Tax Bill.

The amendments to the Finance Bill negative all increases in direct and indirect taxation.

As I understand it, the Party would oppose altogether the Super Tax Bill and the Compulsory Savings Bill. Therefore normally no amendments will need to be moved. At the same time since there is a highly objectionable procedural clause involving a matter of principle, an amendment to clause 3 of the Bill is also suggested. This may be moved either by a back bencher of the Party or by an Independent so as not to weaken the Party's total opposition to the Super Profits Tax itself.

I shall be obliged if you will kindly place these amendments before the Leaders and other members of the Party in both Houses.
