

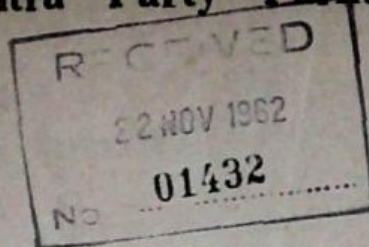

The Minister of Parliamentary Affairs has invited the Members of both the Houses of Parliament to hear the Chairman of the Central Citizens' Committee.
