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My dear Shri Satya Narayan Sinha,

Thank you for your invitation to the meeting you propose to call of M.Ps of both Houses of Parliament to hear the Chairman of the Central Citizens' Committee.

I wish to take this opportunity of protesting against the formation of Committees by Government in respect of the defence efforts which is equally the concern of all sections of the House without even the courtesy of consulting the organised and non-communist recognised Groups in Parliament and their leaders. I may state that in the opinion of a large section of people, the Communists are inalienably aligned with international communism and their loyalties are not primarily to India and so I would prefer that the Communists are not included in such Committees.

As the House and yourself know only too well, we are all keen on promoting the national resistance against the Chinese Communist aggressors and we are already doing our best to help the Defence efforts.
