I have received your letter of the 5th inst. and I am directing our Office at New Delhi to send you the required particulars.

You will be pleased to know that many of our Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha Members contributed to the funds of our Parliamentary Group at Rs.40/-p.m. Patience and persuasion has thus eased the situation. We have opened our account in the Bank and when I left Delhi by the end of last month, we had a balance of about Rs.1,000/- after paying all expenditure for two-and-a-half months. Some members have not yet paid - and we are reminding them about the payment. I have asked our Delhi office to send you full details. All the Members will be soon receiving from our Delhi office Minutes of the Meetings and statement of account till 22-6-62.

You will be interested to know that we have engaged one Shri A.P.Jain of Delhi. Members of our party - appointed to select and approve office-staff had interviewed and selected him. Shri Jain is appointed on probation from 1-8-62 at Rs.400/p.m. He is voluntarily attending our Delhi office for an hour or two just now.

I am returning to Delhi on the 30th inst. as I am appointed on the Customs Bill (1962) Select Committee, and shall be staying there till the middle of September. Before, I proceed to Delhi, I desire to come to Bombay for my personal work. I shall meet you then.

My niece, Girirajkumari, Yuvrani of Maihar - informed me about your views, about her appointment in the Women's Section of the Central Office. She is much disappointed in your decision. Any way we shall talk-over the matter when we meet at Bombay.
