My dear Masani,

Dayabhai would have told you about the outcome of the meetings which the Leaders of the various Parties had yesterday at Mr. Nijlingappa's house. It has been proposed that either on the 15th October when a demonstration is being organised in Delhi or at a later date Leaders of all the Parties should lead the procession and they should be willing to court arrest. Such a gesture would create a tremendous climate in the country and would ^{shake} ~~unearth~~ Mrs. Gandhi completely. I suggest that we on behalf of our Party should agree not only to participate in the demonstration but also support the idea of going to jail. I am prepared to go to jail myself and I think Prof. Ranga will also be willing to do the same.

I will be grateful to have your reaction in this regard for my personal guidance.

My dear Mr. Masani,

Your attention must have been drawn to a Resolution passed by the SSP at Lucknow indicating their intention for moving a Resolution in the coming Session of the Lok Sabha for impeachment of the President for signing the U.P. proclamation. Our Orissa Unit according to Press Reports has passed a similar Resolution yesterday. The Party will have to take a decision on the subject.

There will be a number of no-confidence motions also during the coming Session of the Lok Sabha. I think we should also table a no-confidence Motion so as to try our luck at the ballot. If you agree I would like to keep a signed Motion from you and a couple of other senior Members. I will then ensure that our Motions are tabled well in time for balloting.

Some Members here have also made a proposal that there should be a black flag demonstration at the Airport when the President Mr. V.V. Giri returns from his Eastern European tour. No final decision however has been taken in this regard. Our Members, however, would like to have your guidance on the subject.

My dear Jain,

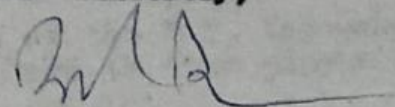
I am in receipt of your letter of October 3. Dahyabhai Patel has already reported to me.
