You must be following developments on the political front which have been taking place during the last fortnight in the country. These developments have serious implications. The country's humiliation at the Islamic Conference at Rabat, non-payment of Income Tax by Mr. Jagjiwan Ram and a number of other topical issues are likely to come up for discussion in one form or the other. There will be voting from the very first day of the start of the session, i.e. 17th November on these issues. Your presence, therefore, in Delhi before that date is absolutely necessary. I hope, therefore, you would make it convenient to be present here one or two days before the start of the session.

To discuss issues of national importance, which are to come up before the Parliament, it has been decided to have a meeting of our Party on Sunday, the 16th November, 1969 at 5.00 p.m. in Room No. 50, First Floor, Parliament House, New Delhi. I request you kindly to make it convenient to attend this meeting also as we have to finalise our Party's attitude to these issues and also to decide our strategy.
