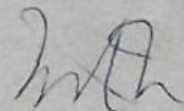
My dear Jain,

My dear Mr. Masani,

As desired I am enclosing herewith a list of delegates to the IPU Conference. I have already written letters to our Members requesting them to contribute Rs. 100/- each for the proposed reception to the IPU delegates on behalf of our Party. Mr. R.R. Singh Deo and Mr. N.K. Somani have already contributed their share, Mr. Piloo Mody, Mr. Loknath Misra have promised to give money today. Dahyabhai who is here will also not hesitate to give the money. I am expecting replies from other members. So from the initial response I feel that there should be no difficulty for us to collect the required sum. Anyhow we can finalise arrangements when you arrive here on the 21st October, 1969.

I made enquiries from the Gymkhana Club. They say they would charge Rs. 15/- for the dinner and Rs. 12/- per head for drinks (two rounds). Therefore as you felt it would be cheaper to have our reception at the Gymkhana Club.

I am enclosing herewith a statement regarding the Rabat Conference issued by some of our Members yesterday. An all-party big public meeting is being arranged here on Saturday to be presided over by Mr. Chagla. From our side Dahyabhai and Mr. C.C. Desai are likely to speak. There is also an all-party informal meeting called by Acharya Aripalani at his house this evening. I have requested Dahyabhai to represent the Party. If they devise some strategy for the coming session in regard to the subject, I will write to you subsequently.

The enclosed condolence card was circulated yesterday amongst all Members, diplomats, journalists etc. This was done at Mr. M.L. Sondhi's initiative. The Statesman has already published its photostat copy in the central page this morning.

If you agree we should have a Press Conference on the 21st or the 22nd when you would be here in connection with your meeting. There are number of developments at home at abroad to which our reactions can be given to the press. I am sure if you agree it will have a very good effect and give a very good publicity. If I have your clearance about the time and the date, I will send a letter to all accredited correspondents here. We can hold the Press Conference in Parliament House or Vithalbhai Patel House.
