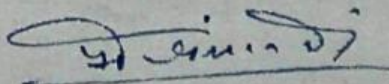
In deference to the wishes of several Members of Parliament expressed in Lok Sabha, Government propose to sponsor officially a visit of a group of Members of Parliament to Ladakh for an on-the-spot study of economic growth and development needs of the region. The Chief Minister of Jammu & Kashmir has welcomed the visit. As per the programme chalked out, the party will leave Delhi on the morning of Friday, the 3rd October, 1969 by I.A.C. flight leaving Palam at 6-40 hrs. to Chandigarh. From there, the party would go to Leh by Air Force Plane. The party will travel from Leh to Kargil and thence to Srinagar by road and will return back to Delhi on the evening of 9th October, 1969 by I.A.C. flight.

A tentative skeleton programme is enclosed in Annexure-I. The detailed programme will be intimated to the members of the group later. The party will consist of 10 Members of Parliament. The Minister of Parliamentary Affairs and Shipping & Transport invites you to join this group and requests you to confirm telegraphically to the Department of Parliamentary Affairs, your acceptance thereof.
