My dear Imam,

You will recall that the Central Parliamentary Board at its meeting in New Delhi on August 31, 1968, had permitted you to move an Amendment to Mr. Nath Pai's Bill, *regarding amendment of Fundamental Rights*.

2. In this connection, the Central Parliamentary Board at its meeting in Bhubaneshwar on October 3, considered a communication on the subject from Mr. Masani to the effect that since he and the Maharaja of Ikrangadhra had already moved an amendment to Mr. Nath Pai's Bill requiring that Fundamental Rights could only be amended through a referendum, your own amendment would cause embarrassment.

3. The Board considered Mr. Masani's view and came to the conclusion that no change was called for in its decision to permit you to table your Amendment, except that you should press your amendment if, and only if, Mr. Masani's amendment is rejected.

4. The relevant extract from the Minutes of the meeting of the Central Parliamentary Board dealing with this subject is attached.
