Dates and Procedure for Party elections

The following office bearers have to be elected for the duration of one year:

Chairman & Leader	1
Deputy Leader	1
Leader in the Rajya Sabha	1
Secretaries	3 (2 for Lok Sabha, 1 for Rajya Sabha)
Chief Whip Lok Sabha	1
Whips Lok Sabha	2
Rajya Sabha	1
Executive Committee Members	6 (4 from Lok Sabha and 2 from Rajya Sabha)

Election should be held on 30th April 1968 between 11 A.M. to 3 P.M. as by that time Members of the Rajya Sabha would also assemble in New Delhi for their session commencing on 29th April 1968.

Nominations for election to various offices should be invited from Members of both Houses. Nomination papers of candidates to various offices should be signed by proposers with the consent of the candidates. Last date for receipt of nomination papers should be a clear week before the election, that is 7 P.M. on 22nd April 1968. Withdrawal date should be by 1 P.M. on Saturday, 27th April 1968. Polling should take place in Parliament House between 11 A.M. and 5 P.M. on 30th April 1968. Polling should be by a secret ballot by a single distributive vote for each office. As for Members of the Executive Committee for both Houses, Members should have as many votes as Members of the Executive Committee for each House but not more than 1 vote to 1 candidate.
