Dear Dr. Pasricha:

There were two things that escaped ^{my} discussion with you when I met you last Friday at Delhi.

One was to request you for the copy of the minutes of the National Executive meeting held on the eve of the formation of the BLD. We had a meeting of the National Executive in Bombay last month and as usual the minutes have to be confirmed. *on the grounds that the National Executive is a body of confidential members, we decided to keep the minutes confidential*

Could you kindly, therefore, let me have the minutes of the last meeting, which I shall return to you after taking a copy of it.

The second is about the demonstration before the Parliament on 6th March under the leadership of Mr. Jayaprakash Narayan. While we shall try to get a few volunteers outside Delhi to join the demonstration, could you arrange for about 20/25 people there to join the same. For us, the act is more symbolic in terms of our support to JP's movement. Do please consider this matter seriously.
