My dear Haribabu,

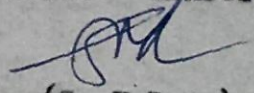
Thank you for your letter of 12th June. I have perused the contents of the Pragati Party meeting and particularly the P.S. to your letter. I can smell what is going on.
