My dear Raju,

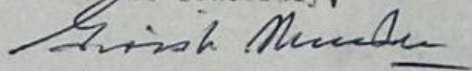
After my discussion with you I thought about the whole thing afresh. I must confess I am not certain what would happen to the assets of the Maharashtra Swatantra Party and whether they would swallow our Office premises. I have discussed with our friends the letter of Piloo. Quite a few of them are averse to the idea of finishing the Swatantra Party when the alternative he presents is dubious. What seems to be troubling them, as it does me, is that the new party, without the Congress O and the Jan Sangh is an attempt by Charan Singh to get back for himself an all India status which he has lost as the BJD Chief.

If however the new party comes about, (I wonder how our other units will decide) our assets including tenance rights would, I presume, go to the new party.

But we should discuss this out with our friends.
