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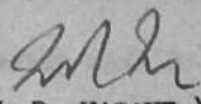
I attach a draft passage of the minutes and a draft item and would very much appreciate your approval with such alterations as you both may wish to suggest. I am sure you will appreciate that, unless the minutes and the item on the agenda refer specifically to the non-compliance with the resolution of July 22, a technical objection is likely to be raised against any action being taken by the General Council arising out of this non-compliance such as, for instance, the dissolution of the State Committee and unit as suggested by you.
