My dear Rajaji,

On second thought, I feel sorry that I allowed myself to be carried away by the crusading zeal of our General Secretary in coming to a decision about Ramgarh and deciding upon its publication in Ramgarh's absence.

Apart from departing from a courtesy due to a colleague it would be depriving Ramgarh of an opportunity of adjusting his ambitions with the needs of the Party organization. He may or may not, but I feel that the Resolution should not be put into force or published till Ramgarh arrives in India and has an opportunity of having a talk with you.

I shall feel relieved if you issue instructions that the Resolution should not be issued till we have further consultations in the matter.
