My dear Rajaji,

I forward herewith extracts from the draft minutes of the Parliamentary Sub-committee meeting on the 4th and 5th January in so far as they relate to the Bihar jeep credit issue. I would like to have your approval of the minutes before issue just in case of later controversy and their possible use in the litigation that you foresee.

2. I may mention that I consider the recording of my report and Rangarh's assurances contained in para 5 of the first day's proceedings to be essential for the future protection of the Party's interests in case there should be further trouble.

3. If you do not wish to have any changes made, kindly send me a telegram approving of the minutes. If you wish any changes made, may I kindly have your suggested alterations.

4. I enclose herewith two clippings in regard to company donations. The Indian Express report may be worth reproducing in Swarajya since it bears out your earlier statement and contradicts the Prime Minister's later one.

5. I wonder if you would be so good as to indicate to me the likely dates of your visit to Bombay in response to your commitment to Kripalaniji and to Orissa? So long as I know these dates, I shall try and plan my movements accordingly. I should also like the Orissa people to know that you are going there since Ranga is the only person who has made such a commitment on our side.
