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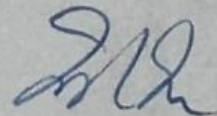

My dear Munshi,

* I forward herewith a note in regard to the current position re: Bihar Jeep Credit which I have prepared as it is possible that an attempt by Ramgarh to reopen the matter and extort further concessions may be made in Bangalore. I trust you will find it in order. Many thanks for your help in this connection to the Central Office.

first Since you mentioned on the telephone yesterday that you might not be coming to Bangalore, I wonder if, in that event, you would be good enough to address a letter to Rajaji or Prof. Ranga with a copy to myself stating your view on the correct position to take in this matter. I assume that you would endorse the advice which you and Mr. Dara Mehta of Little Co. have already given, that we should now refuse to get involved in further discussions and let things take their course unless Ramgarh puts himself right by carrying out assurances he had given earlier, and making it possible for us to respond.
