My dear Masani -

I forgot to inform you that the Rajah of Rampur replied to my appeal to settle that Bank loan & fees etc, sent through the Rajah of Naksadpur that the only outstanding claim he has to make on our Central party is the payment of interest on that loan. It seems, that claim has been accepted by us, as per the resolution of our Subcommittee. Do kindly look into this matter and see if by some sacrifice, if need be, on our part, this unfortunate dispute can be settled amicably.

I am today writing Mahaswami Sagathi Devi about the Jain Ramph's role in Jaipur Municipal elections and asking her to send you the relevant facts & findings etc.

Shri C. L. N. Reddi observed, later on, that Rs 2000 will not be enough to cover the ^{train} expenses of Jain.

My idea re the report to be submitted to the Convention about the work of the Parliamentary Party is that a fairly comprehensive report should be drafted by Jain and reviewed by you and Kaper Singh, if available in Delhi and then, its copies to be distributed among the members of the General Council i.e. 150 members; but you may add only a few paragraphs about it in your S. Secy's report. You may give more time to Jain for the preparation of the detailed report.

I have to leave this place by the 27th for the @vira tour which will take 4 days i.e. till the 2nd Jan. I have also to go to Tanjore by the 11th Jan and then come to Bombay by the 14th Jan.

I request you to settle the details of my Gujarat tour bet 15 - 20th or 21st Jan as you think best, in consultation with Shree Keshubhai-Patel & B.D. Patel & the Saurashtra leaders.
