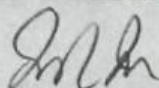

Dear Sir,

Since Mr. Bateshwar Prasad Singh, who claims to be the Constituted Attorney of Shri Kamakhya Narain Singh of Ramgarh, has sent me a copy of his letter to you of 23rd June, I wish to correct certain misstatements he has made in paragraphs two and three of his letter.

As you are aware, the Swatantra Party and its Central Office had and have nothing whatsoever to do with the overdraft account of Shri Kamakhya Narain Singh of Ramgarh with your Bank nor has the Party or its Central Office made any payments to the Bank. Such payments as may have been made to the Bank have been made by or on behalf of Shri Kamakhya Narain Singh. You are, of course, well aware of this position but, since Mr. Bateshwar Prasad Singh has in his letter misstated the position, I am clarifying the matter so that you may not in any way be misled by what he has written.
