My dear Raja Saheb,

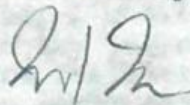
I regret the necessity of having to write to you for the third time about Jeep No: BMC-5256 which was taken possession of by you from Mr. Janki Nandan Singh. We have not heard anything in response to my letters of 18th April and 8th May whether the Jeep was on its way to Bombay.
