My dear Raja Saheb,

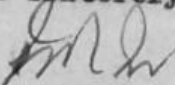
* You have already received I trust the draft minutes of the meeting of the Parliamentary Sub-committee held in Bombay on 14th March. May I invite your kind attention to pages 3 and 4 of those minutes (extra copy attached), where, arising out of the Treasurer's Report, certain decisions are recorded in regard to the repayment of the bank credit for jeeps under paragraphs marked (a) and (b) respectively ?

In so far as paragraph (a) is concerned, I shall be obliged if you will let me know when you propose to repay the sum of Rs.1.20 lacs and the interest that has accrued in respect of this credit so that we may make arrangements to follow up your action in the manner that has been decided. In the meantime, needless to say, we are continuing to pay on your behalf the monthly instalments of Rs.240000

In so far as paragraph (b) is concerned, I have already written to you on the 18th, requesting you kindly to return jeep no. BMC 5256 loaned to the Bihar Party by the Centre which itself had been loaned to us by a friend on the understanding that it would be returned to the owner immediately after the elections. I await news from you in this connection. On the jeep being received, I shall write to you authorising you to retain the jeeps belonging to the Centre and to get them registered in the name of the Bihar State Party, who would act as trustees for the jeeps on behalf of the Centre as decided at the meeting of the Parliamentary Sub-committee.
