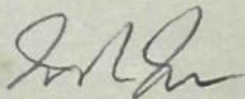

You have to take the Bihar Jeep Credit and other files to Mr. Munshi and see that he applies his mind to it from the legal point of view so that I may discuss the matter with him on my return. If in the meanwhile, he wishes to prepare a note giving the legal opinion about the extent of our commitment, if any, to the Raja it would be good if such a note is prepared by him for our discussions.

In my last letter to him I have already summarised the position but it should now be worked out in detail.
