The following resolutions were passed :-

- (1) Whereas the Bihar Party has already launched the election organisation in a large number of units, with Organisers, Unit Officers and other staff, the Committee views with deep concern the distentnuance of the monthly contribution from the Central Office towards the organisation of Lok Sabha units in Bihar and is of opinion that the discontinuance of the subsidy leading to the stoppage of the work, which is in full swing, will not only be highly detrimental to the interests of the Party and its prestige but will also seriously prejudice its chances of success at the next Elections. The Committee, therefore, resolves that the Central Organising Committee of the Swatantra Party be requested to modify their decision dated the 30th and 31st

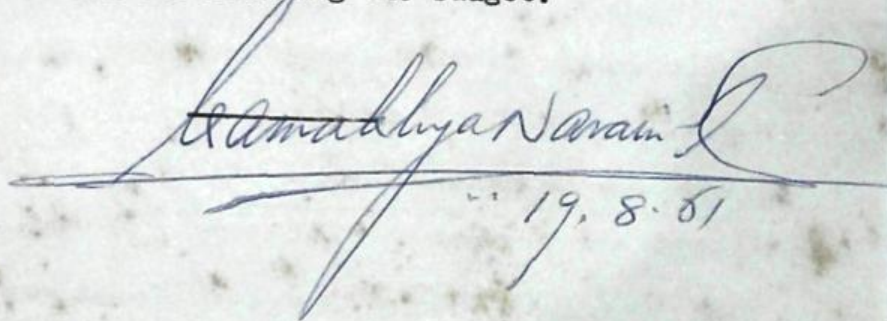
July 1961 at Madras, through circulation, so as to continue the monthly contribution of Rs. 25,000/- to Bihar.

Further resolved that the decision of the Central Organising Committee may kindly be communicated to the Bihar Party before the end of August, when Shri K. M. Munshi and Shri M. R. Masani are due to visit Bihar.

(2) Resolved that the diversion of Rs. 9000/- from the amount received from the Centre to the General Account be approved and the balance be used for the purpose for which sanction had been received.

(3) Resolved that after new Jeeps have been supplied and after steps have been taken to ensure regular publication and despatch of the Party Paper Swatantrata, enrolment of subscribers for the Swatantrata and of members, as laid down in the Circular, should be insisted upon as a condition for the continuance of the prescribed monthly subsidy.

(4) Resolved that in view of the present financial difficulties a Sub-Committee, consisting of the President, the two Vice-Presidents, the two General Secretaries, the Treasurer as Convenor, and Sri Imam Ali, be formed for raising funds and for revising the budget.
