My dear Mr. M. R. Masani,

I am in receipt of your letter dated the 18th May 1961. While we are all grateful for the kind approval of Rajaji, Prof. Ranga, Sir Homi Mody and yourself for the Bihar Party to raise loans to the extent of Rs. 5 lakhs only in anticipation of Centre's contribution to Bihar, the figure of Rs. 5 lakhs is not very clear to us. Bihar's request for an assistance of Rs. 10 lakhs has been agreed to at Bombay in addition to the monthly contribution of Rs. 25,000/- from May to December 1961. You had also intimated to the Bihar State Working Committee of this decision. I hope, therefore, that you will kindly clarify this position.

As regards Centre's contribution to be spent only on such constituencies as are endorsed by the Parliamentary Sub-Committee, the State Presidents, I suggest, should please be given discretion in the matter.
