My dear Masani,

I have just read the report in the press of the Congress (O) Working Committee proceedings. What I fear is a Tweedledum and Tweedledee position which will lead to people choosing between Nehru's daughter and Nijalingappa. It must be made clear that socialism without detriment to any of the rights regarding property and occupation inscribed in the Constitution is very different from socialism at the cost of those rights which will be a statist economy and the reduction of the citizen to serfdom.
