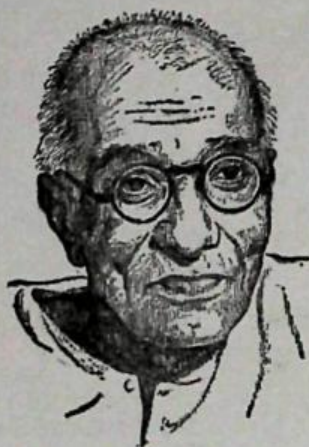

THUMBNAIL SKETCHES

NATIONAL EXECUTIVE MEMBERS

C. Rajagopalachari



Elder statesman, savant and guiding spirit of the Swatantra Party, Rajaji was born in a village near Hosur, Salem District. Educated at Bangalore and Madras he joined the Bar in 1900. In 1919 he joined the Satyagraha campaign, and in 1920 the Non-cooperation movement. During Gandhiji's imprisonment Rajaji edited the former's paper, *Young India*. Rajaji was the General Secretary of the Indian National Congress in 1921-22 and a member of the Congress Working Committee from 1922-42 and again from 1946-47. He served sentences of imprisonment on five occasions in freedom movement campaigns.

Rajaji was a member of the Council of the All-India Spinners' Association from the beginning upto 1935. Secretary, Prohibition League of India and also Vice-President of Dakshina Bharat Hindi Prachar Sabha.

He became Prime Minister of Madras in July 1937 but resigned in October 1939 with other Congress ministries. He resigned in April 1942 from the Congress on account of difference of opinion. In the Gandhi-Jinnah talks in September 1944 he assisted Mahatma Gandhi.

He was a member of the Governor-General's Council from September 1946 to August 15, 1947, holding the portfolios of Industries and Supplies, of Education and Finance for different periods. He became Governor of West Bengal in August 1947. Acting as Governor-General of India from November 1947 he became Governor-General of India in June 1948 and held that high office till January 26, 1950, when he retired. However on Mr. Nehru's special request he again joined the Union Cabinet as Minister without Portfolio in December 1950. Later he took over as Home Minister and retired in November 1951. The discomfiture suffered by the Madras Congress after the 1952 elections made it seek Rajaji's help to form a ministry. He thus served as Chief Minister of Madras for another two years from 1952 to 1954.

He was among the first recipients of Bharat Ratna and has a number of books to his credit.
