Minutes of the meeting of the Executive Committee of the Swatantra Party, Maharashtra held on 18th June 1998 at the Party's office at 143, Mahatma Gandhi Road, Mumbai 400 023.

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Mr. S. Ramachandran was duly proposed and seconded to chair the meeting. Leave of absence was granted to Mr. J. Venkiteswaran.

The minutes of the earlier meetings held on 11-6-1997 and 20-12-1997 were read, confirmed and signed by the Chairman.

The meeting was presented with the draft Income and Expenditure account and the Balance Sheet of the party prepared for the year ended on 31st March 1998. The entries made therein were verified and after discussions the accounts were passed.

Mr. Sampat informed the meeting that the appeal against the judgement in the notice of motion No. 663/90, filed against the Courier Publications and others have been filed in the court of the Chief Judge and the Addl. Chief Judge bench of the Small Causes Court. The notices have been served on the respondents (original defendants) of the said notice of motion and the original suit No.252/282/90.

The results of the General elections to the parliament were discussed. The verdict of a hung parliament and later the Bharatiya Janata Party forming the Government with the help of several parties were discussed. Fears of the Government not completing its full term were expressed.

There being no other business for discussion, the meeting terminated with a vote of thanks to the chair.

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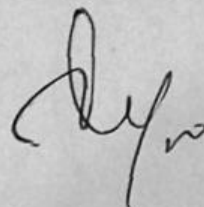
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
