Leave of absence was granted to Mr. J. Venkiteswaman as he was was not keeping well. Mr. S.V. Raju was duly proposed and seconded to chair the meeting.

Minutes of the meeting held on 7-7-94 & 26-9-94 were read, confirmed and signed by the chair.
The draft Income and Expenditure account and the Balance sheet for the year ended 31st March, 1995 were placed before the meeting and the same, after scrutiny and discussions were passed.

The political situation in the country and Maharashtra in particular were discussed in detail, The situation in the State of Maharashtra, after the take over of the Government by Mr. Manohar Joshi of the Shiv Sena and their alliance with the Bharatiya Janata Party were discussed and apprehensions of a decent and good governance were raised. Mr. S. Ramachandran was requested to take such measures and actions necessary to reactivate the party.

Mr. Sampat informed the meeting that the writ petition challenging section 29 (A) of the Representation of the people act, was filed in the Bombay High Court on 15th December, 1994. Mr. Rajiv Patil has been appointed to plead the party's case. Mr. Raju informed the meeting that he had joined Mr. Sampat as the second petitioner in his capacity as the editor of Freedom First.

The meeting terminated with a vote of thanks to the chair.

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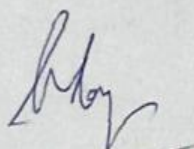
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
