

Draft Minutes of the meeting of the Executive Committee of the Swatantra Party, Maharashtra held on Tuesday A-uqust 21, 1990 at the Party Office, 143, Mahatma Gandhi Road, Bombay 400023.

The minutes of the previous meetings held on 22nd June, 1989 and July 30, 1989 were read and confirmed.

Matters regarding the premises at 143, Mahatma Gandhi Road, Bombay 400023 were discussed and the following decisions taken:

- 1) To file a suit in the Small Causes Court, Bombay immediately for eviction of the AFTERNOON.

In this connection Mr. Nitin Raut was instructed to take the assistance of senior Advocate Mr. R.S.Bhalekar and when necessary.

The position regarding the unauthorised tapping of electricity by the AFTERNOON from our meters was discussed. The correspondence exchanged between Swatantra Party, Maharashtra and the B.E.S.T. as also with the Palton Road Police Station were examined. After discussion it was decided as follows:

- 2) To file a suit in the City Civil Court, Bombay against the AFTERNOON.

It was also agreed that Mr. Nitin Raut should seek the assistance of a senior advocate conversant with the Indian Electricity Act for this purpose.

It was decided to give a monthly pension of Rs.60/- (Rupees sixty only) to Kalidas during his life time. The method of remittance will be decided by Mr. J. Venkiteswaran.

It was decided to activate the Swatantra Party and in this connection various proposals were discussed and Mr. S.V. Raju was requested to draft a suitable announcement in the Indian Express and seek the financial help of senior leaders of the Party for this purpose.

For funding the various activities including the legal expenses to be incurred immediately for fighting the Court cases, against Mr. Ratansinh Rajda and the AFTERNOON it was agreed to raise immediately an additional amount of Rs.5000.00

Mr. S.V. Raju, Secretary-Trustee of the Adult Education Institute agreed to contribute Rs.3,000/- from the Institute subject to approval of the other Trustees of the Institute and Mr. P.N. Subramanian agreed to contribute Rs.1,000/-. The balance Rs.1,000/- will have to be collected from Swatantra Party members.

The present arrangement of sharing the electricity bill on a 50/50 basis pending decision by the City Civil Court between the Swatantra Party, Maharashtra and the Adult Education Institute will continue.

The Statement of Accounts for the year ended 31st March, 1990 was approved and accepted.

The meeting terminated with a vote of thanks to the chair.
