My dear Mr. Masani,

I am enclosing herewith a statement showing divisions in the Lok Sabha on socio-economic issues since 1967-68. As the debates are printed only till 21st August 1968, I could not complete statement beyond this date regarding voting behaviour of the Swatantra and the Jan Sangh.

The information is also being collected in respect of divisions in the Rajya Sabha.

I am enclosing herewith a clipping from the Statesman of to-day which you will find interesting. It is in regard to the Jan Sangh's attitude over Naxalites. Unfortunately, they have again fallen into the communist trap by refusing to participate in the Home Minister's round of talks with various political parties to find ways and means of stopping activities of the extremists. The last two paragraphs of the news items refer to our forthcoming meetings on the 26th and 27th May. The Jan Sangh itself seems to me to be the source of this information.
