GENERAL SECRETARY'S LETTER NO. 126

The National Executive of the Party at its meeting in Bombay on May 29, 1966, discussed steps to prepare a draft Election Manifesto for placing before the next Convention of the Party.

2. It decided to set up a Drafting Committee consisting of the President, Prof. N. G. Ranga, the Joint Secretary Mr. N. Dandekar, and myself.

3. The Executive called upon State Units to make suggestions for inclusion in the draft Manifesto, as also to prepare and submit draft State Manifestos.

4. May I suggest that it might be useful for your Unit to set up a small Drafting Committee to:

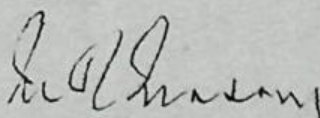
a. Submit suggestions for inclusion in the Central Draft Manifesto, and

b. to draft a Manifesto for your State

5. The Executive further decided that the Party's Manifesto should be circulated well in advance of the next National Convention (in the first half of November) to ensure thorough discussion and consideration by the National Executive and the Party's members before being placed before the National Convention.

Could you kindly, therefore, arrange to ensure that your suggestions, as also your draft State Manifesto, are received by us not later than 31st August 1966? In fact, it would be appreciated if you could send it earlier.
