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## GENERAL SECRETARY'S LETTER NO. 125

Dear Friend,

The meeting of General Secretaries of State Units, held in Bombay on May 29, 1966, considered among other things the problem regarding renewal of membership and the replacement of lost Workers' Cards.

2. Arising out of this discussion it was decided that a Worker who has lost his Card can either be given a new one or a receipt in lieu of the Card as and when his membership comes up for renewal.

3. This means that whenever a Worker loses his card, the question of replacing it should be taken up when his membership comes up for renewal. At that time, he should be given a fresh one. However, against his entry in the register, the new card number should be noted at some appropriate place. It might be useful to stamp the card 'Duplicate'. State Units may make a nominal charge for the duplicate if they so desire.

4. Another question discussed was in regard to the formation of Constituency Committees. It was explained to those present that wherever membership enrolment had sufficiently progressed to warrant such a step, it was perfectly in order for elections to be held at the Constituency Committee level. Insofar as their representation on the District Committee is concerned, the new constituency committees could send their representatives to the District Committee in the same proportion as may have been fixed for the others.
