There was a brief discussion on the proposed reference of the Mysore and Maharashtra dispute to a Parliamentary Committee.

The Leader detailed the deliberations at the Meeting, the Speaker had in connection with the Privilege Motions of Mr. Koushik and other Members. It was decided that in future the Member concerned, who is so assaulted or harrassed by the police be allowed to make a statement and the decision then as to what action should be taken be left to the Speaker.

At the Leaders' Meeting there was also a brief discussion on the Constitution (24th Amendment) Bill when some Members had indulged in double voting. Leaders demanded that a proper punishment should be awarded by the Speaker to such of the Members who indulged in double voting.

It was decided that the Party should oppose any attempt on behalf of the Government with the help of some of the Parties to change the Voting procedure on the Constitution Amendment Bills. The Party was in favour of existing procedure to continue.

Mr. Masani detailed the talks which ^{he} was having on behalf of the Party with the Leaders of other Parties in regard to the formation of a common bloc in Parliament.

The Meeting adjourned with a vote of thanks and the cheers.
