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GENERAL SECRETARY'S LETTER No. 119

Sub: Filling Vacancies in the General Council

Dear friend,

The National Executive of the Party at its meeting in Bombay on May 26 and 29, 1966, considered the question of providing for the filling up of vacancies on the General Council. The following decision has been taken in this regard :

"That whenever such vacancies occur and are declared to exist by the Central Office, the State Councils concerned will be permitted to fill up such vacancies either at a duly convened meeting or by circular to all members of the State Council."

It may kindly be noted that vacancies will be declared by the Central Office only if

- a) a member of the Council resigns from the Party or from membership of the General Council and if such intimation is received by the Central Office, or
- b) if a member of the Council is expelled from the Party or debarred from holding office on its Committees by a decision of the National Executive, or
- c) if the member in question dies.
