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GENERAL SECRETARY'S LETTER NO. 118

Extension of Term of office of Party Committees

Dear friend,

The General Council of the Party, which met in Bombay on May 27 and 28, 1966, considered a resolution recommended by the National Executive for prolonging the term of office of the present Committees beyond the end of 1966 and adopted it in the following form :

"In view of the General Elections in 1967 and the desirability of concentrating on them, the General Council resolves, subject to the approval of the National Convention, that the term of office of all elected bodies and office bearers of the Party be extended beyond the end of 1966 by not more than one year."

This Resolution enables all elected Committees and whose term of office would in the normal course have ended in December 1966 to continue till after the General Elections. This does not, however, mean that the subscription of the Workers has also been extended. All workers, including members of such Committees, are expected to renew their subscriptions as and when they fall due, in the absence of which they would cease to be members of such Committees.

May I request you to kindly ensure that all those who are currently members of the various Committees renew their subscription? The question of a time-table for fresh elections next year will be considered by the General Council when it meets on the eve of the National Convention later this year.
