General Council Circular No. 22.

Dear Friend,

In continuation of General Council Circulars No. 21 and 21(a) of April 20 and 25 respectively, by which notice was given of a meeting of the General Council of the Party in Bombay on Friday and Saturday, 27th and 28th May at 10 a.m., notice is given of the following additional item to be placed on the agenda of that meeting:

- 2(a) Consideration of a proposal of the Central Parliamentary Board that in articles 4(d), 5(d), 5A, 7(heading), 7(a), 7(b), 7(c), 11(d), 12(a) of the Party's Constituency (copy attached), the words "Parliamentary Constitution" should be substituted for the word "District".

2. Enclosed herewith are two papers. The first is the General Secretary's Report on Organisation under item 2 of the Agenda. The second is a note prepared by Mr. J. M. Lobo Prabhu on "Strategy for the General Elections". May we request members to keep both the notes confidential and to ensure that they bring them with them for the meeting. Koppiker, Joint Secretary of the Bombay Unit of the Party, as requested in General Council Circular No. 21 of April 20, 1966 about whether or not they will be attending the meetings. In addition to details re : reception, accommodation etc., sent to you along with General Council Circular Letter No. 21, we are happy to inform you that dormitory type of accommodation is available at the Palm Beach High School, Darabsha Road, Off Napean Sea Road Bombay - 6, at a nominal cost of Rs. 5 per day for the 26th, 27th, 28th and 29th. This includes transportation to and from the venue of the General Council meeting.
