GENERAL SECRETARY'S LETTER NO.116

The President/General Secretary

Dear Friend,

When the Central Parliamentary Board met in Madras on February 26 and 27, I was glad to be in a position to inform the Board that, if funds permit, some modest assistance of Rs 100 per month may also be made available for prospective Assembly candidates approved by the Central Parliamentary Board who do not form part of a Parliamentary constituency which the Party proposes to contest. Naturally, such candidates should not number half or more of the Assembly seats in any Parliamentary constituency as, otherwise, the Party should also put up a candidate for Parliament. The Board welcomed this information.

2. In the light of this development, which I am sure you too will welcome, your State Parliamentary Board may now proceed to recommend suitable prospective Assembly candidates in the kind of constituencies referred to above. Naturally, each such recommendation should be accompanied by the data outlined in General Secretary's letter No. 97 of March 23, 1965.
