GENERAL SECRETARY'S LETTER NO.115

Dear Friend,

The Central Parliamentary Board of the Party met in Madras on 26th and 27th February, 1966. Among other things, the Board reviewed the functioning of the scheme for the nomination of prospective candidates.

2. Arising out of this discussion, the Board decided that in view of the rapid onset of the General Elections, from now State Parliamentary Boards should at the same time make recommendations in respect of both prospective Parliamentary Candidates and as many of the Assembly Candidates within the Parliamentary Constituency as possible. This means that from now on the recommendation of a prospective Parliamentary Candidate will be considered only if it is accompanied by that of as many Assembly Candidates as possible from the Parliamentary Constituencies concerned.

* 3. These recommendations should be accompanied by data outlined in the General Secretary's letter No.97 of 23rd March 1965, in the usual manner. In this connection, we are enclosing herewith a model recommendation of a prospective candidate for your guidance.
