General Secretary's Letter No. 102

Dear Friends :

Although a month has passed since General Secretary's Letter No. 97 of 23rd March, I am sorry to say that not even a single Unit, including yours, has as yet responded to the request made in paragraph 5(b) on page 1, viz., the early submission of a list of Parliamentary Constituencies, in their order of priority, giving reasons why the State Parliamentary Board considers them worthy of inclusion in the list.

2. Would you kindly consider this a matter of high priority and arrange for a meeting of your State Parliamentary Board to consider such a draft list prepared by your office bearers, along with the reasons under the heads mentioned in General Secretary's Letter No. 97, and let us have it not later than the middle of May? I may explain that this is necessary if the Central Office is to be able, in the light of this material, to make its recommendations to the next meeting of the Central Parliamentary Board when it meets in Madras on June 4.

3. We are sure you will appreciate that, if there is any delay on your part in submitting such a list approved by your State Parliamentary Board, the Centre cannot be blamed for the consequential delay in the consideration of any proposals from you in regard to prospective Parliamentary candidates.
