General Secretary's Letter No. 165

Dear Friend,

As you are aware, the biennial elections to the Rajya Sabha will be held some time in February 1968. In order to avoid having to take decisions on hasty last minute nominations, it has been decided that recommendations of candidatures from State Units should reach the Central Office not later than 31st December, 1967, so as to enable the Central Parliamentary Board to take early decisions.

2. Please therefore let me know on or before that date whether your State Parliamentary Board desires to set up candidates for the forthcoming biennial election to the Rajya Sabha and, if so,

- (i) to let me know further how many vacancies you propose to contest (with or without the support of other Parties or Groups) and the reasons for believing that you can succeed in winning so many vacancies;
- (ii) to recommend twice as many names as the number of vacancies which you wish to contest : thus, if you propose to contest two vacancies please recommend four names;
- (iii) the names should be arranged in the order of preference, with reasons for each recommendation.

3. In this connection, I am sure that earlier commitments, especially those (if any) already endorsed by the Central Parliamentary Board, will not be overlooked.

4. Will you kindly ensure that your recommendations in the manner indicated above, reach us not later than the 31st December, 1967?
