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## FOR FAVOUR OF PUBLICATION

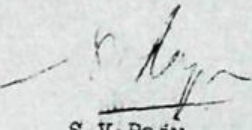
At its meeting in Madras on September 29, 1967, the National Executive of the Swatantra Party discussed the current political situation in the country. Discussing the attitude the Party should take in regard to State Governments dominated by Communists, the Executive was unanimous that the Party should cooperate in efforts to get rid of Communists from Governments dominated by them e.g. West Bengal.

It was in this context therefore, that on hearing of the resignation of Dr. P.C. Ghosh from the West Bengal Ministry and the withdrawal of support to the United Front Government by 16 other Legislators, Mr. M.L. Masani, M.P. sent the following telegram on Saturday November 4, 1967 to Dr. P.C. Ghosh:

"ON BEHALF OF SWATANTRA PARTY AND MYSELF EXTEND OUR WARM  
CONGRATULATIONS ON YOUR PATRIOTIC DECISION TO STRIKE A  
BLOW FOR DEMOCRACY."
