NATIONAL EXECUTIVE CIRCULAR No. 22(C)

Dear friend,

State Councils Mysore and Andhra Pradesh State Councils

In continuation of National Executive Circulars No. 22(A) and 22(B) we forward herewith further recommendations in regard to the Mysore and Andhra State Councils.

In the case of Andhra we submit our proposals alongside the Andhra proposals. We feel that the maximum per district viz. 501 and above fixed by the Andhra executive for a district to reach the maximum of 10 on the State Council is on the high side especially in the context of their total enrolment which is 5,059. Instead we recommend the Ratio adopted by the Orissa Unit which requires an enrolment of 315 per district to entitle it to the maximum representation of 10 on the State Council.

While our recommendation does not materially affect the total strength of the State Council it makes it easier for unorganised districts to aspire for a better representation in the State Council in due course of time.

Could you kindly on receipt of this circular indicate your wishes on the attached self addressed card and return it to us? If we do not hear from you on or before Friday September 15, we shall presume you approve the proposals made by the Mysore State Unit in Col. (4) and by us in respect of Andhra in Col.4(b).
