National Executive Circular No. 22(A)

Dear Friend:

State Councils
- Bombay Regional
and Rajasthan Units

Under Clause 8(b) of the Party's Constitution the strength of each State/Regional Council has to be prescribed by the National Executive.

2. For this purpose we asked State Units to submit their proposals in terms of :

- a) The ratio of representation on the State Council to number of Workers enrolled;
- b) The allocation of seats on the State Council to each organised district;
and
- c) The resulting strength of the State Council.

3. Normally we should have placed these recommendations before a meeting of the National Executive. Unfortunately the Executive is meeting on September 29 and 30 - much too late for this purpose. Hence the Circular.

4. Moreover we would have awaited replies from all State Units holding Party elections before circulating their recommendations for the approval of the National Executive. Unfortunately not all Units keep to the deadline and those who are prompt have to suffer for no fault of theirs. Hence on this occasion we would like to circulate to you the recommendations received from State Units as and when they come in. Thus this circular seeks your approval to the attached recommendations received from the Bombay and Rajasthan Units of the Party, as tabulated in Col.(4) thereof.

5. To avoid delay we enclose herewith a self addressed card. Could you kindly indicate your wishes and return it to us on receipt of this circular? If we do not hear from you on or before Monday, September 11, we shall presume you approve the proposals made by the State/Region in Col. (4).
