Dear Friend,

Scrutiny & Verification

Further to General Secretary's Letter No. 157 of June 28, 1967 and with particular reference to paragraph 4 of that letter, this is to inform you that Mr.

has been deputed as the Centre's representative to verify your Unit's registers and related books of account. He will communicate with you the date on which he proposes to visit your State Office for the purpose.

2. In the meanwhile, it is necessary that enrolment forms, Membership Registers, related books of account etc., be kept in readiness for scrutiny at your end. Incidentally, we trust that the enrolment of Workers/Life Workers has been processed in the manner prescribed viz. considered and approved by the State Committee or by an enrolment sub-committee.

3. It will greatly facilitate the work of the Centre's representative if the following is attended to by your State Office before the visit of our representative :

i. All enrolment forms in respect of which register entries have been made (and of which copies have been forwarded to the Central Office) must be made available.

ii. The Membership Registers must be kept in order. There ought to be three separate registers, viz :-

- a. Workers Register
- b. Life Workers Register
- c. Register of Life Members enrolled on or before December 31, 1963 and who have not converted their membership to that of either a "Worker" or a "Life Worker".

iii. A separate page(s) should be allotted in each Register for each of the Primary Units decided upon by your State or Regional Committee (viz. either "Assembly Constituency" or Taluka Tehsil-wise).

iv. There should also be prepared a Summary Statement (showing only membership figures) arranged Districtwise indicating as of June 30, 1967 --

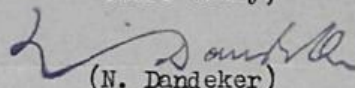
- a. The Primary Unit areas where membership enrolment of 20 Workers/Life Workers has been completed
- b. The Primary Unit areas where enrolment has been less than 20, and
- c. The Primary Unit areas where there has been no enrolment at all.

4. The books of account should indicate the allocation of subscription as between Primary, District and State Units and the Central Office.

5. Copies of Membership Register entries may kindly be handed over to the representative in the event of your being unable to send it along with the Centre's quota of subscriptions.

6. Since Party elections in your State can commence only after your membership has been certified by the Central Office, we trust you will attend to the above intended to facilitate verification of membership records pertaining to your State.
